Diamond Buses Free Travel update

It is expected that many major supermarkets will open early for the elderly and disabled to be able to access essential items.

In order to help support the elderly and those with disabilities access essential services during the Coronavirus outbreak, Diamond Buses will accept National Concessionary Passes for travel **before 9:30am** from Thursday 19th March until further notice, in the West Midlands and Worcestershire concessionary boundaries.
